Be safe!

- Supervise children closely.
- Be aware of unsteady footing, especially near the water's edge.
- Do not go near the water with children.
- Bring drinking water.
- Wear a hat, long pants and bring a long-sleeve shirt.
- Wear sturdy shoes.
- Bring sunscreen and mosquito repellent.
- Bring work gloves.
- Do not attempt to remove anything that may cause injury or presents a biohazard (ie: hypodermic needle); report it immediately to the Rangers for expert removal.
- Do not enter a campsite that may be in use.
- Do not confront persons engaging in unlawful activity.
- Learn to identify and avoid poison oak.
- Never attempt to handle snakes or other wildlife.
