
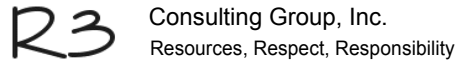
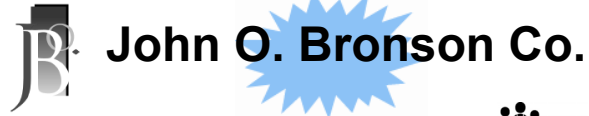

Sacramento Area Bicycle Advocates

The Sacramento Area Bicycle Advocates (SABA) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit group dedicated to representing cyclists and making cycling safe, convenient and desirable.

We work to increase bicycle use in our community as a healthy, pollution-free (and greenhouse gas free) practical mode of transportation—to have many more everyday trips made by bike. We want more places like the beautiful American River Parkway bike trail. Even more, we want you and everyone in your family to be able to go anywhere by bike—without fear or danger.

Our mission statement sums it up. SABA represents bicyclists. Our aim is more and safer trips by bike.

We've accomplished a lot already, with a good deal of it related to the American River Parkway. We've fought for and gotten more funding for the Parkway. SABA has sought improved access to the parkway, additional parkway trails and trail improvements such as use of rubberized asphalt, trail relocation out of flood prone areas, the Hazel Undercrossing, the Sunrise Corridor Trail, the Hwy 50 Overcrossing at Hazel, the Lake Natoma south shore trail, a new access point behind the Radisson Hotel, the paved trail access at Hazel and the steep NW corner and bike racks at restrooms.

SABA has adopted Mile 8 of the trail and cleaned up, planted and maintained the Sacramento Northern access to the parkway trail. Our "goathead" team is trying to get rid of nasty puncture vine.
